

**Washington College Sailing
2007 Spring CR-914 Regatta
May 19, 2007**

Notice of Regatta

The Washington College Sailing Team invites you to participate in the 3rd annual CR-914 Spring Regatta to be held at the Washington College Sailing Center in Chestertown, Maryland on Saturday May 19, 2007.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the rules of the CR-914 class, except as any noted in section 1.2 and by this notice.
- 1.2 The RRS and class rules are amended as follows:
 - (a) Rule 31.1 Boats may hit marks of the course without penalty.
 - (b) Rule E3.2 Course Boards may not be used on the racing docks at all times.
 - (c) Rule E4.5(b) is amended to read: While ashore or at the water's edge, boats may be adjusted, drained of water or repaired, have entangled objects removed, or have batteries changed.
 - (d) Rule E3.5: the starting sequence will be either sixty or thirty seconds long at the discretion of the Race Committee.

3. Location of Regatta

Truslow Boathouse next to the Leila Henson Boating Park in Chestertown, Maryland

4. Eligibility

The regatta will be sailed in CR-914 class sloops.

5. Registration

Participants may pre-register for this Regatta by completing the attached Entry Form. Entries may be submitted via e-mail to gbecker2@washcoll.edu, faxed to Geoff Becker at 410-778-7741, or brought to registration prior to the competitor's meeting on May 19, 2007. Each participant is asked to pay an entry fee of \$10.00.

6. Frequency assignment

Frequencies will be assigned in the order of entry. Once an entry is received the frequency will be noted and saved for that entry. Please include multiple frequency options on the registration for in the case of two entries with the same frequency. There will be some frequencies available at the regatta for standard HiTech radios, but these will be limited.

7. Social Activities

The Saturday lunch will be a cookout style barbecue, made available at a minimal charge, held in the Leila Henson Pavilion.

8. Driving Instructions to Washington College Boating Park

FROM PHILADELPHIA AND POINTS DUE NORTH & NORTHEAST:

Take I-95 South to Exit 1-A (Middletown/Route 896 South). Follow 896 approximately 10 - 15 miles where it will merge with Route 301 South. Continue straight on Rt. 301 South into Maryland. Take Galena exit (Rt. 290 South) and turn right at bottom of ramp. At stop light, go straight on Rt. 213 South. Follow to Chestertown. In Chestertown, turn right at the Cross Street traffic signal and follow for approx ½ mile. The Truslow Boathouse will be on the left hand side of Cross Street after the old train station.

FROM BALTIMORE, BWI AIRPORT, AND POINTS NORTHWEST:

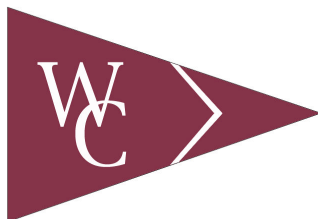
From Baltimore beltway 695, take I-97 south toward Annapolis, then Rt. 50/Rt. 301 east toward Annapolis and the Bay Bridge. Follow Rt. 50/Rt. 301 East past Kent Island, then take Rt. 301 North toward Wilmington at Rt. 50/Rt. 301 split. After about 7 miles, take Rt. 213 North exit toward Centreville and Chestertown. In Chestertown, turn left at the Cross Street traffic signal and follow for approx ½ mile. The Truslow Boathouse will be on the left hand side of Cross Street after the old train station.

FROM WASHINGTON D.C. AND POINTS WEST:

Take the route of your choice to Rts. 50/301 East and follow the signs for Bay Bridge/Annapolis. On the Eastern Shore continue on Rts. 50/301 until they diverge in Queenstown and proceed North on Rt. 301. Exit Rt. 301 at Rt. 213 North. In Chestertown, turn left at the Cross Street traffic signal and follow for approx ½ mile. The Truslow Boathouse will be on the left hand side of Cross Street after the old train station.
